Insurance Coverage Checklist

Prior to your initial nutrition visit, or anytime your insurance changes, we recommend that you contact your insurance company directly to be familiar with your coverage for nutrition counseling. Here are some helpful tips to navigate this process.

Questions to ask insurance:

- Do my benefits cover nutrition counseling?
 - **Tip:** You can provide your insurance company with procedure codes 97802 and 97803 as well as the name/NPI for your dietitian (see below). Of note, all providers within Unconditional Nutrition RI are covered under Adriana Brayman's tax ID number.
- Are there any limitations for diagnoses that are covered under my plan?
- Do I have a deductible on my plan?
 - **If Yes:** Will nutrition visits fall under the deductible for my plan? When does my deductible start? How high is my deductible? How much is left until my deductible is met?
- Are there any limitations for coverage (such as a number of covered visits per year)?
- Is there a copayment that will be due for nutrition appointments?
- You may consider asking for a written explanation of your benefits and/or a confirmation number for your telephone conversation.
